



The instructor Joseph Guadagni was prepared for class and presents material in an organized manner.








Course Questions

The recitation quizzes are confusing. I feel like they should be adjusted again since I don't even understand the questions being asked half the time and I know a lot of students complain about the recitation quizzes. I think another improvement could be the coordination between lecture and recitation. While recitation is helpful since it reinforces concepts, the class turnout is extremely low in all sections since most of the time recitation is more confusing than lecture since the two teaching styles are different. In lecture, I feel like I am comfortable with the material and then in recitation I'm lost some of the time.
