Comments
Sometimes, the methods that are taught in lectures are not the same as what is taught in recitation, and it would have been easier to follow if instructor Hamidreza and Professor Echeverria could maybe coordinate that a little better.
I would ease the students into their first Matlab assignment more gently. A lot of my classmates as well as myself had no prior knowledge in programming, and the assignment was very lengthy and difficult for us. Our TA was not very helpful in preparing us for the assignment.
More textbook homework problems, as they tend to be of higher quality than MyLab homework problems.
I would maybe try to micromanage a little bit more so that students are up to speed on homework that needs to be done at the time of an exam. The shorter deadlines may incentivize quicker and maybe more thorough engagement with course material.
More focus on the ending material from 16.4 onwards.

Professor Echeverria presents information in a way that is easy to follow and he even tries to physically demonstrate a few concepts during lectures, which also aids understanding. He is also very reasonable, understanding, and replies to emails super fast, so whenever we have issues, they are solved pretty much immediately.
Professor Mariano's enthusiasm in teaching this course made it interesting and fun to learn. He was also mindful in asking the class if we all understood the material, which encouraged students who didn't understand to speak up so he could spend more time explaining the subject. This was very beneficial. I fully enjoyed this class and wish that I could've taken it in person.
He helped me develop much interest in the course, and simplified the concepts and techniques of the topics well.
He always made sure we understood the topics when someone asked a question, and made even the boring material interesting and exciting. Also, when someone wasn't getting a concept at first he would be able to explain it different ways to help the learning.

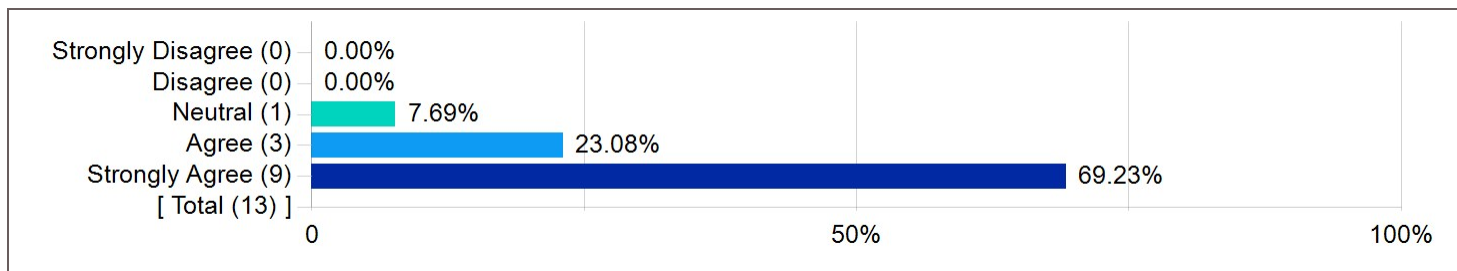

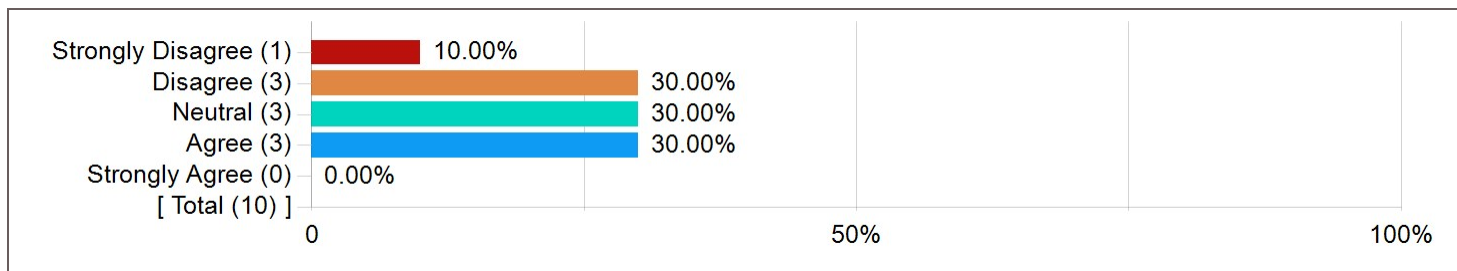

The lecturer posted content that helped me understand the topics covered in the online lectures.



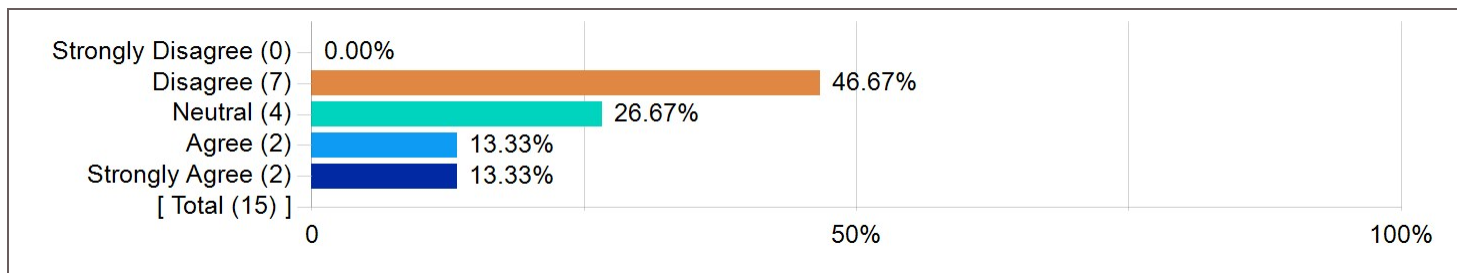

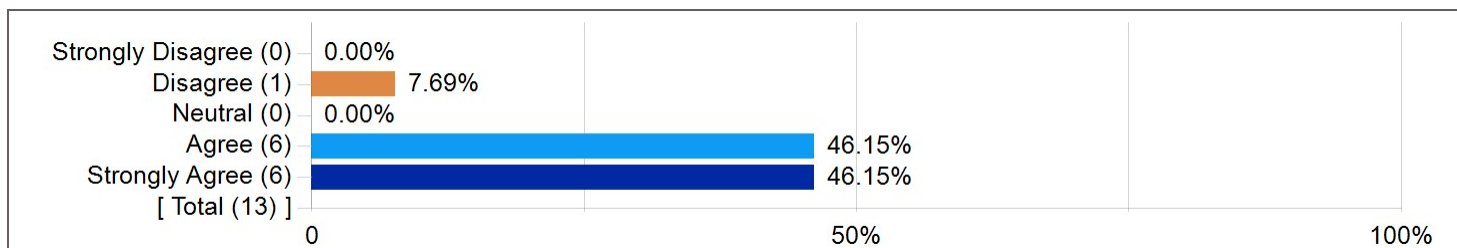

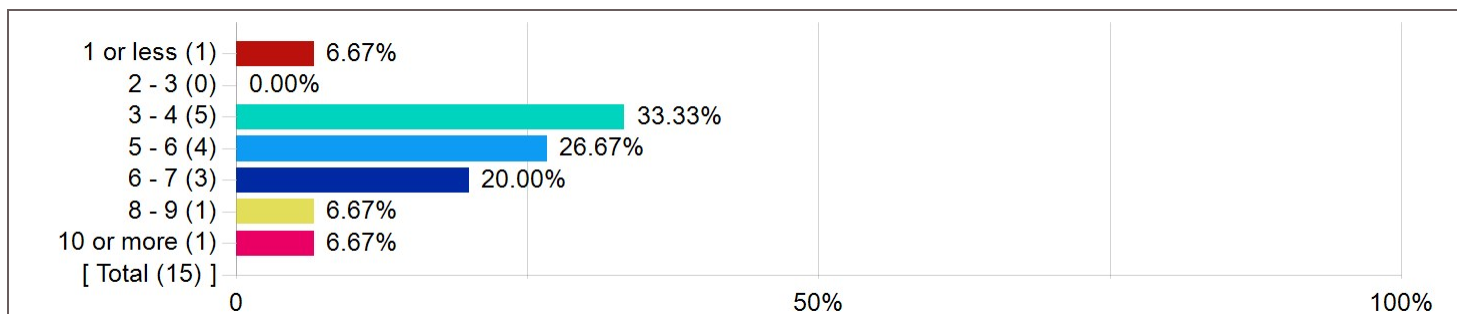

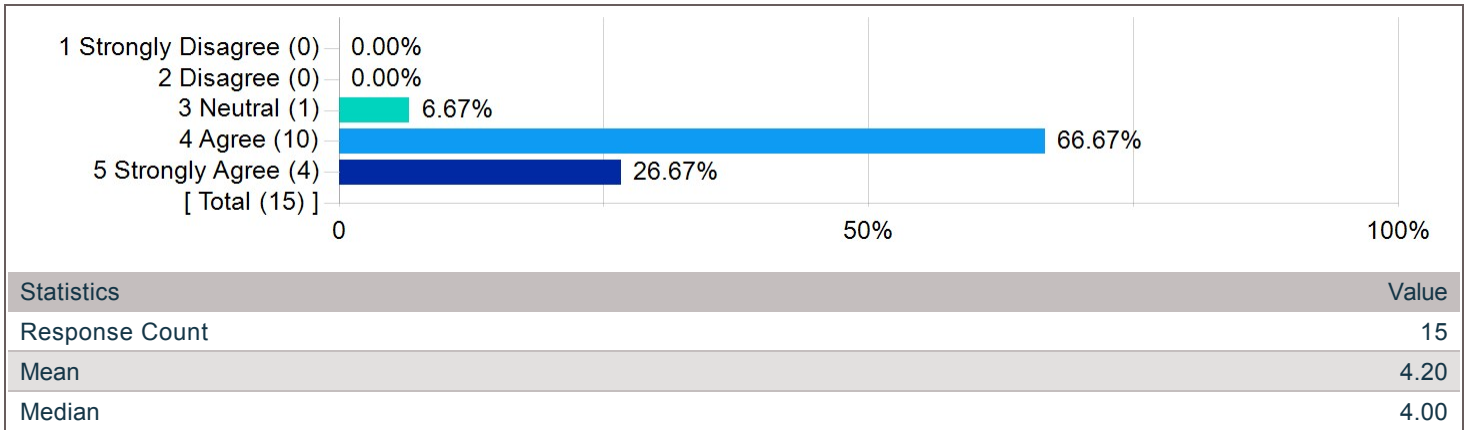

Since the beginning of this course how many hours a week, on average, have you spent on this course in addition to class time?

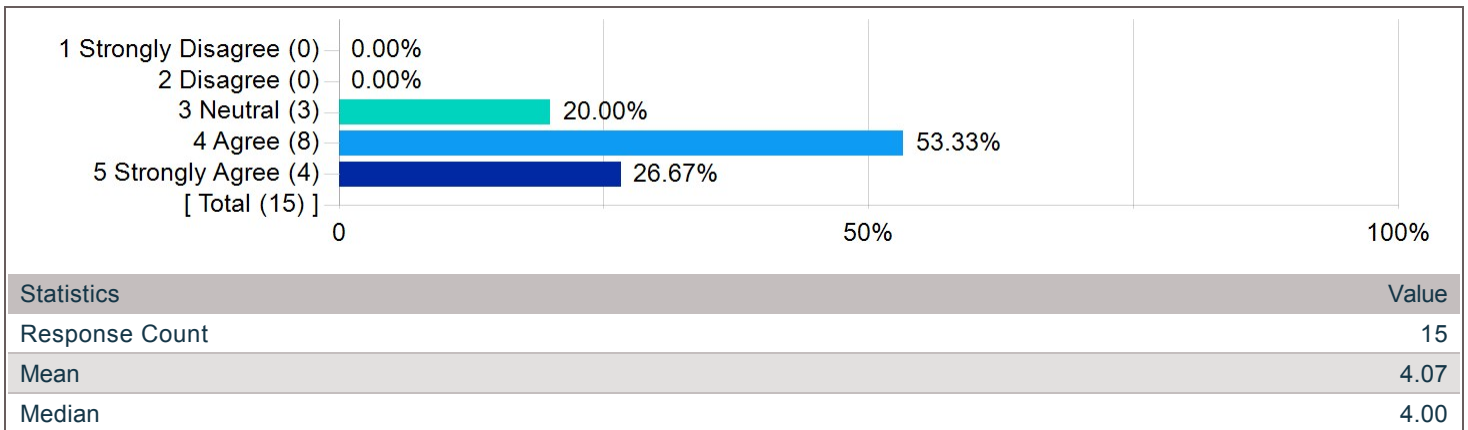

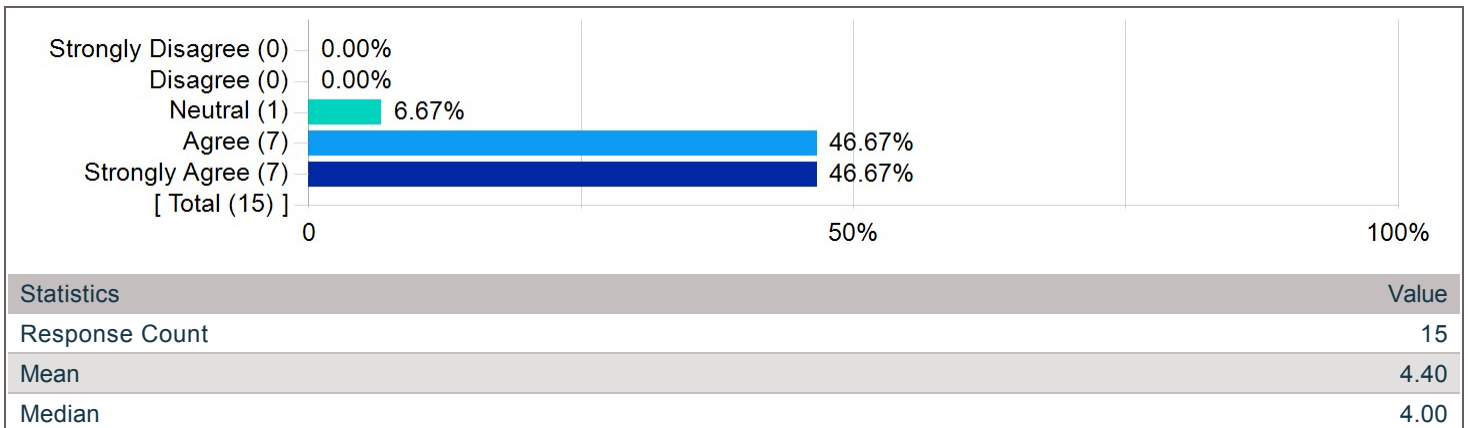
The workload for the course was appropriate.
