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Dr. Karl-Heinz Indlekofer completed his Ph.D at Albert-Ludwigs-Universität Freiburg im Breisgau in 1970. His dissertation was called *Summierbarkeit Verhalten äquivalenter Potenzreihen*. This translates to *Summability Behavior of Equivalent Power Series*. He had two advisors. The first one was Wolfgang Karl Schwarz. The second one was Theodor Schneider.

He completed publications in several subject areas. The primary one was Number Theory. Some others were Fourier analysis, Functional analysis, Functions of a complex variable, Group theory and generalizations, History and biography, Measure and integration, Probability theory and stochastic processes, and Sequences series & summability. He also wrote a new approach to probabilistic number theory compactifications and integration referenced work by Ramanujan. His publications are very known, and used all over the world.
