Victor Moll was born in 1957 and received his B.S in 1978 in mathematics at Universidad Santa Maria, M.S in 1982 in Mathematics at New York University, and his PhD in 1984 at New York University. Moll first started his postdoctoral position at Temple University in Philadelphia from 1984 to 1986 and is currently at Tulane University in New Orleans as a Professor of Mathematics since 2001. Moll's research interest are classical analysis, Symbolic Computation, Special Functions and Number Theory. His most recent publication was "A triple integral analog of a multiple zeta value" that was published in 2021. Moll has 139 publications, 851 citations, was first published in 1984, was most recently published in 2021, has a Erdos number of 2, has a Zeilberger number of 2, and has 16 PhD students.
