A Brief Biography of Gert Almkvist

Dr. Gert Einar Torsten Almkvist is a mathematician who studied his Ph. D for University of California, Berkely where he studied under Dr. Gerhard Paul Hochschild where he did his dissertation on fractional categories. Prior to receiving his Ph. D he studies at Lund University in Sweden. After receiving his Ph. D in 1966, he was a research professor at Lund University. During his time there he took on 3 doctoral students in 1988, 1992, and 1999, after which he did not take on any other Ph. D students. In 1982, he attended the Ramanujan Centennial Conference as an expert in combinatorics and number theory. His most recent research published in 2021 was Glaisher's Formula and its related generalizations. Almkvist's primary research topics focused on the applications of number theory and algebraic transformations, and differential equations. To the extent of available information, it appears that Dr. Almkvist is currently still a professor of mathematics at Lund University.
