Mr. Gatti has several hundred head of steers which he is feeding in the valley for the Clifton market. This bunch of cattle have just cleaned up 114 tons of alfalfa at the Gila ranch and now are moving to the Stephens farm where a hundred tons more have been bought to finish preparing for the slaughter pen.

Live Stock Market.

KANSAS CITY, Feb. 23, 1912.—Cattle received here this week 28,100; last week 29,800, same week last year 35,300. Buyers have alleged for some time that local cattle prices were too high, with relation to prices at other markets, and they started out this week to eliminate the margins in favor of this market. Their best day was Tuesday, when they made inroads of 10 to 25 cents on prices of middle class cattle, but they have had indifferent success since that day, because of the small runs since then. Another thing that has partly defeated their purpose is that other markets were on the decline the first of this week also, mainly because too many cattle were bunched at Chicago Monday. The distemper of buyers is further augmented by the bad killing qual-
