

On Aug. 14, 1983 my brother Abe Rocklin and I left Nogales, Arizona and drove to Magdalena, Sonora, Mexico. We stopped for a while at San Ignacio where I photographed the old mission. It was built in about 1680. I should check it out when I get back to Los Angeles.

In Magdalena, we drove almost directly to the home of Señora Juilleta Moreno de Contreras. We were uninvited, however, the family was very hospitable. Juilleta was born in Nogales, Ariz. (Dr. Gustetter was her Doctor) and lived on Terrace St.. She went to school in Tucson, Miles elementary, and then Manfield Jr. High. She speaks perfect English and Spanish. She married Carlos Contreras in Sonora. They have 8 children. I think she's about 55 years old. Mr. Contreras is now retired. He is about 65; he was a school teacher, and then a miner. Julietta is the Granddaughter of Don Pedro Faerber of Magdalena, Sonora.

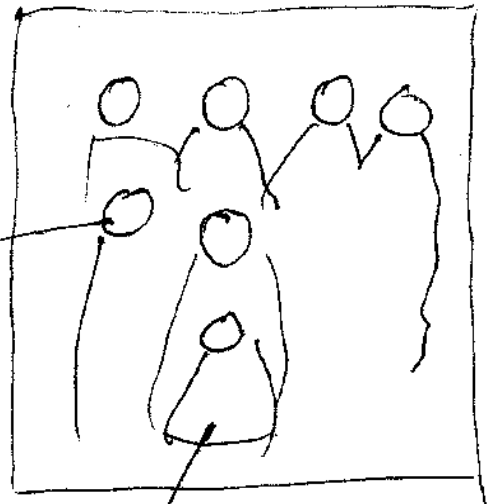

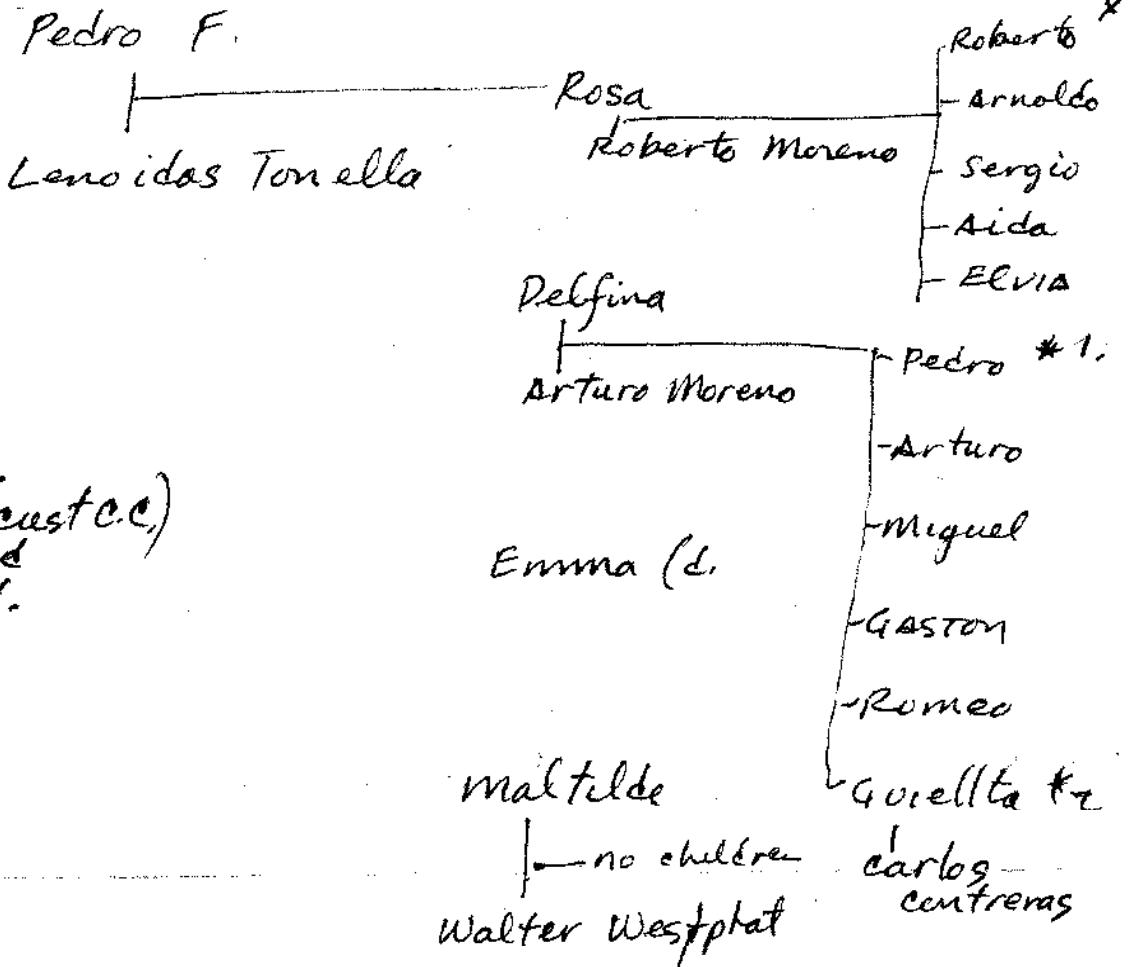
